

Consent to Use Creme, Gel or Ointment

Dear Early Childhood Parents:

According to Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, we need parental consent if we are to use any creme, gel or ointment on your child.

In most cases of small injury a Band-Aid will suffice. Sometimes, after we have cleaned an injury with soap and water, we like to use a Homeopathic creme/gel/ointment; such as Arnica for bruises, and Calendula for cuts and scrapes. We may also use Beeflower creme (a compound of Sunflower oil and beeswax) for dry hands or Vaseline for dry lips.
